PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The Craig Holbrook Parham Scholarship Fund of the First Baptist Church of Greenwood, SC, was established in 1986 for the sole purpose of providing scholarship assistance to students pursuing degrees from accredited theological seminaries for full-time Christian service. The Scholarship Committee reviews every application thoroughly and prayerfully. Awards are based on determination of need and availability of funds. It is therefore imperative that all applications be fully completed. Failure to fully complete the application or omission of any portion of the application will result in automatic rejection. All Board decisions are final. There is no appeal process. All applicants must reapply each year; however, photographs, statement of doctrinal belief and pastor letters of recommendation are not necessary for repeat application. Please check our web site (fbcgwd.com) and choose the scholarship link to make certain that you are using the most current application. Application deadline is 30 April of each calendar year. All applicants are duly notified of Board decisions. Awards are mailed in August and December.

Memorials must not be allowed to become solemn and rigid reminders of a presence no longer possible. It is hoped that Parham Scholars will find in the award inspiration for their personal lives and ministries far beyond the financial incentive it represents.
