






The Senior Pastor candidate will give their testimony in the Sanctuary during the 10:00 am Sunday School hour on Sunday, April 7. Following the Sunday School hour, the candidate will preach during the 11:00 am worship service which will not be live-streamed.

It is imperative that confidentiality be maintained until a call is extended to the candidate and they have had an opportunity to notify their current congregation.
